During the course we recommend PicMonkey to resize images. This used to be a free service. Unfortunately that's changed and there is a monthly fee of \$4. If you think you'll need the service regularly, then it's worth spending the money. Otherwise you can sign up for a free 7 day trial and resize your images at once. Don't forget to cancel to avoid being charged!
